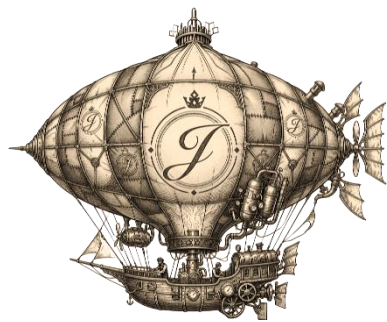

PREMIUM BLACK TEA: *Infusion Time 3-7 mins*

Black teas contain about half the caffeine of coffee, and research has shown drinking 4+ cups a day reduces the risk of stroke and heart attacks.

These are pure leaf estate teas, can be drank easily without milk.

Darjeeling (Margaret's Hope) (+25p) TGFOP

Margaret was the daughter of the owner at the time who fell in love with the area and its beauty and hoped to come back to live there. She returned to England but died on the way home. Her father renamed the estate in her honour.
Widely regarded as the Champagne of Tea.

Assam (Bukhial) (+15p) TGFOP

Grown on the southern foothills of the Himalayas, on the banks of the Brahmaputra river. Slower growing than other Assams producing a better flavour

★ **Kenya (Lelsa) FBOP**

Situated in the Lelsa sub district of Tinderet in Kenya, the teas from this region are widely regarded as one of Africa's greatest ever teas.

HERBAL: *6-8 mins. Don't add milk.*

Tea made from herbs rather than from the tea plant *camellia sinensis*, still has major health benefits such as digestive or wellbeing but nothing like Oolongs, White, Black or Green teas.

OOLONG: *1-2 mins. Best without milk or sugar.*

With increasing research pointing to help lowering blood pressure, cholesterol and body fat, Oolongs are fast becoming the health drink.

CHAI: *1-2 mins. Best with milk and sugar to taste.*

GREEN TEA: *2-4 mins. Best without milk.*

Whilst green tea comes from the same plant as black tea, it is processed differently retaining more antioxidants. Helps burn triglyceride fats, prevents heart disease and possibly reduces cancer risk.

FBOP – Flowery Broken Orange Pekoe TGFOP – Tippy Golden Flowery Orange Pekoe

Flowery refers to the leaf taken from the end bud and first leaf of each shoot. **Broken** means leaves that are not perfect, perhaps split or incomplete. **Golden** means the youngest most freshest leaves. **Tippy** means the tips of the leaves. **Pekoe** is of Chinese origin, thought to mean the leaves are picked when the buds have fine hairs on them. **Orange** is thought to refer to the Dutch Orange-Nassau tea company.
